Power	Patrick	9Mar1890	1836 Co Wexford Ireland	Cath	Captain Power, 5 crew and 2 passengers drowned when Alex Kethel's top sail schooner <i>Agnes</i> was wrecked 6 miles north of the Bruns. Two other unidentified bodies were recovered and buried with Power in the Catholic portion of the cemetery.

Marshall	Robert	24Dec1921	1837 Plymouth, England	CofE	Son of Solicitor Alexander Marshall and Susan Ryder. Married Elizabeth Malone at age 32 and Sarah Louisa Jennings at age 52, both Sydney
Marshall	Sarah Louisa	18Dec1921	1849 London, England	CofE	Daughter of Edward Jennings and Ellen Allen. Made a claim for the Jennings fortune. Married Jergen Soll of Denmark 1878 London. He died 1890 London and she migrated 1891. Married Marshall as Sarah Soll 1900 Sydney.
